



WPF Sudoku GP Director

Job Description

Overview: The Sudoku GP Director's primary duty is to run the online tournament hosted by the WPF at the WPF GP web page

To achieve this, the Sudoku GP Director may undertake the following tasks, or appoint a capable person to them.

1. Communication

- Communicate with the contributing countries and receive the puzzles and solutions in good time - submission deadline is 1-2 months prior to the competition.
- Communicate with the GP website owner (currently Karel Tesar), provide booklets and solution codes on time
- Communicate with testers. Testers should be provided with both the puzzle and intended solution. Testing should be both for time and a uniqueness of solution (which should match the intended solution). Testers should provide suggestions for rows for solution codes.
- Manage the GP Forum and answer all the general queries raised by the participants

2. Publication

- Three files per round to be produced in PDF format: Instruction booklet (IB), Competition booklet (CB), Solutions booklet (SB). The puzzles, solutions, puzzle point distribution, and list of puzzle authors are to be provided by the authors.

3. Testing

- Make sure all the puzzles are tested and puzzle booklets have no mistakes
- Determine the time needed for solving
- Make sure the competition remains consistent across rounds

4. Judging

- Make decisions about partial bonuses, which are currently awarded to solvers with exactly one "minor" error
- Manage the face-to-face finals

5. Feedback

- Get feedback about the GP. There are no restrictions about the content -- either emails or the GP web page can be used for the poll or survey.
